"While those will be useful Sunday morning, they really don't help me right now."

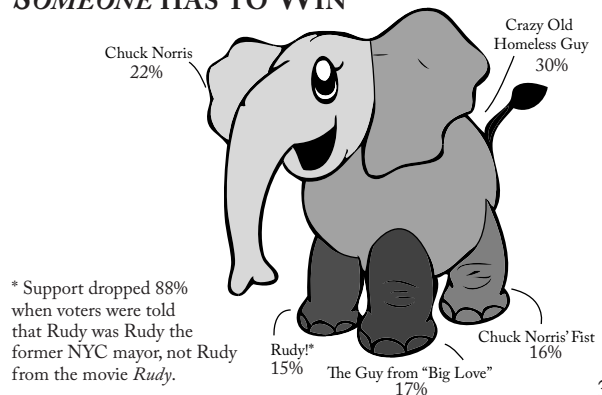
The heath center chose not to comment, but they did release their recommended treatment for zombieism: a combination of cough drops, Tylenol, and condoms.
